Kathryn Duthie brought information on a new location for our Open Car Show for next summer. The information is as follows:

Wait Park- (The city block bordered by NW 3rd and 4th streets, and NW Grant and Holly streets.) Canby, OR

-On Sundays during the summer there is a concert in the park. Depending on the time of the concerts (Kathryn is checking) we might be able to have our car show at a little later time and enjoy the music that is already there.

-If we choose to have the show earlier, and want music, we would need to hire a DJ.

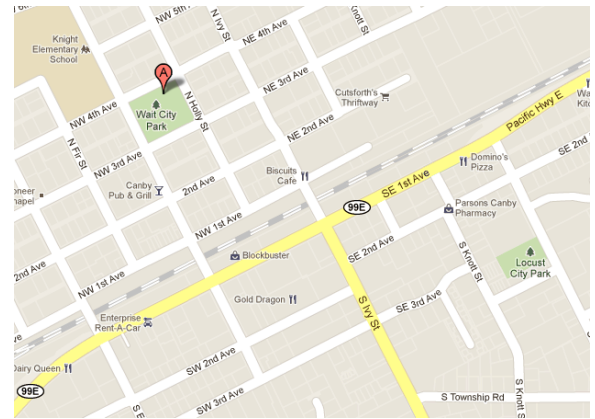
-The fee is \$ 750 for non- residents, The fee for residents is \$375, and the fee to block off the street is \$50. Since the Duthies' are Canby residents, we would be able to get it for the resident fee, plus the street fee. \$425 would then be our cost.

-Cars would be parked on the street (that would be blocked off) and we could use the park to set up our other activities.

-Brad has a bull horn that we could use to make announcements.

Septembers meeting will be held at the Canby Pub Annex, 211 N Grant St., Canby, OR , at 7pm. We will need to meet at Wait Park at 6pm, 350 N Grant Street to look over the grounds and see if this is a location we would like to use for the Open Car Show next

summer. Directions – At N. Grant St. & 99E which is 1st Ave in Canby turn north go 3 blocks and the park is on your right. Look for members parked on the street. We can then walk the short distance to the Canby Pub Annex to have dinner and finish up any other business we may need to take care of. If you have other ideas for locations you would like to see us have this show, please bring your information with you to this meeting so that we can discuss your ideas.



We would like all of our ideas in and re-searched so that we can take a vote at the November meeting, and start making plans. Please bring any pertinent information with you , such as price for use of location, grass or concrete, electrical hookups available, food available, etc.

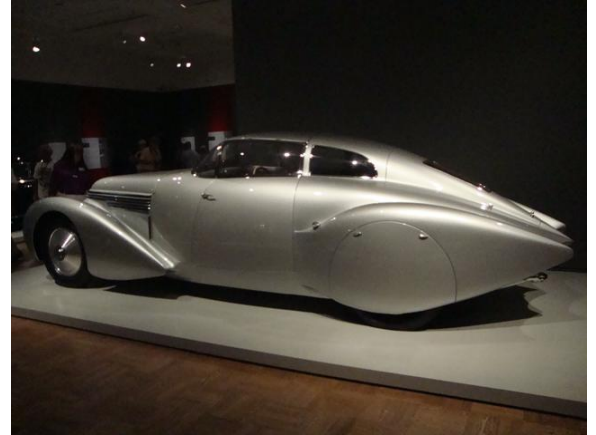


“The Allure of the Automobile”
